Volunteer Victim Advocates will provide hospital accompaniment for victims of sexual assault. Volunteers will also be required to take shifts for our 24-hour hotline and provide crisis counseling to anyone who calls.

In order to be a volunteer with the Family Resource Center, you must be at least 18 years of age, pass a criminal background check, sign a confidentiality agreement, and complete a 25 hour volunteer training, which we provide for free.

This is an excellent opportunity to gain experience & training in the area of Victims' Services for individuals seeking degrees in psychology, sociology, social work, and counseling.
